

Grass and Yard Waste Recycling

NO GRASS CLIPPINGS WILL BE COLLECTED WITH THE TRASH

The Township has established yard waste sites at designated areas for **Township of Spring residents ONLY** to deposit grass clippings and yard waste. The dropoff locations are along Reedy Road near State Hill Road and Goose Lane near Sage Drive. **GRASS OR YARD WASTE MUST BE REMOVED FROM PLASTIC BAGS** prior to depositing at designated areas. It takes longer and we incur increased costs if you leave your grass in bags - so **PLEASE EMPTY THE BAGS.**

Leaf Collection and Recycling

Curbside leaf collection by Township crews will begin the second week of October and continue through the first week of December. Leaves should NOT be placed in bags or containers for curbside collection or recycling. Leaves will be collected from each area of the Township on a weekly basis. Inclement weather, equipment breakdowns, or other emergencies may alter the collection schedule.

Christmas Tree Drop-off - Through January 31, 2008

Christmas Trees can **ONLY** be dropped off at the two Yard Waste sites. Goose Lane near Sage Drive & Reedy Road near State Hill Road.

DO NOT DROP OFF CHRISTMAS TREES AT ANY OTHER LOCATION!!!

Trash Collection REMINDER: NO SPRING AND FALL CLEAN UP.

Days for Trash and Recycling will remain the same. **Please refer to the calendar on other side for Holiday Collection.**

NOTE: Trash should be placed at the curb the evening before the scheduled trash collection day but not more than 24 hours in advance of scheduled pick up.

A total of **FOUR CONTAINERS** (bags or cans) may be placed for the weekly collection. Each container shall **not** exceed **32-gallon** capacity nor weigh more than **40 lbs.** All loose items must be bundled not to exceed **18 inches by 18 inches by 36 inches.**

In addition, **ONE BULK ITEM** may be placed at the curb for collection each trash collection day. **There will be NO SPRING AND FALL CLEAN UP.** Each trash collection day you will be allowed one bulk item, i.e. mattress, furniture, television etc or one additional trash container. The following items **will not** be picked up as a bulk item: **NO APPLIANCES – washers, dryers, refrigerators, microwaves, stoves, dishwashers, dehumidifiers, air-conditioners, hot water heaters, propane tanks, batteries, automobile motors, transmissions, nor tires, etc. Paint cans may not contain paint in liquid form.** Lawn mowers may **NOT** have fluids in them. If you are unsure if an item will be collected please call the Township Office, **FIRST.**

Recycling Collection

Recycling collection shall continue to be scheduled every other week. Please refer to the attached Recycling Schedule to determine the day for your household.

There is no limit on the amount of recycling a residence can place at the curb.

MOST PAPER CAN BE RECYCLED. PAPER SHOULD BE TIED OR PLACED IN A BAG NEXT TO RECYCLING CONTAINER.

- Magazines
- Junk Mail
- Corrugated Cardboard – **must be bundled**, no larger than 18 inches by 18 inches by 24 inches.
- Shredded Paper
- Catalogs
- Office Paper
- Paperback Books
- Telephone Directories

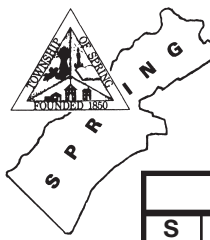
ITEMS TO BE PLACED IN RECYCLING CONTAINER:

- Clear Glass
- Green Glass
- Brown Glass
- **PLASTICS IN BOTTLED FORM ONLY – remove all lids**
PETE (#1 Plastic) HDPE (#2 Plastic)
- Aluminum Cans
- Steel Cans
- Bimetallic Cans

Bulk Clean Up For Limbs/Branches - Absolutely No Grass

Limbs and branches will be collected door to door on Monday, March 31, 2008 and Monday, September 29, 2008. Limbs and branches **must** be tied and properly bundled – maximum size 48” x 18” x 18”. **No roots from trees/shrubbery.** Trimmings shall be tied, placed in an open container or paper lawn and leaf bag. **ABSOLUTELY NO TRIMMINGS IN PLASTIC BAGS AND NO GRASS WILL BE COLLECTED.**
