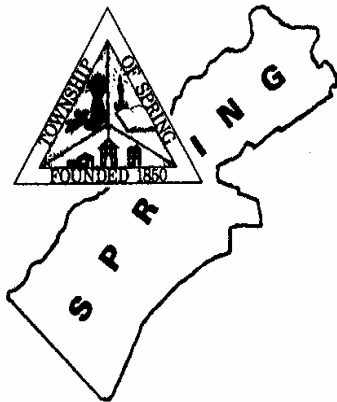

MEETING MINUTES JANUARY 9, 2007

Reorganization:

Chairman: Nominations having been opened and closed, a motion was made by Mr. Vaughan, second by Mr. Gibbs, to appoint James Oswald as Chairman of the Transportation Advisory Committee for 2007. Upon roll call, all members voted affirmatively.

Vice-Chairman: Nominations were opened and closed, and a motion was made by Mr. Gibbs, second by Chief Messner, appointing Mr. Vaughan as Vice-Chairman of the Transportation Advisory Committee for 2007. Upon roll call, all members voted affirmatively.

Note: Alan Kreider has filled the position vacated by Mr. Myers, who was appointed to the Township Zoning Hearing Board.

Regular Business:

Minutes: A motion was made by Chief Messner, second by Mr. Vaughan, to approve the Minutes of December 12, 2006. Upon roll call, all members voted affirmatively with the exception of Mr. Gibbs and Mr. Kreider, who abstained.

New Business:

Mogel/Kerns Subdivision: Representatives of the Mogel/Kerns Subdivision were advised that an ad hoc committee met to discuss necessary road improvement to Chapel Hill Road, along the frontage of the Mogel/Kerns Subdivision. Mr. Vaughan read a draft memorandum listing improvements discussed and recommended by the ad hoc committee. Mrs. Krater will discuss the recommendations and costs with her clients. A motion was made by Chief Messner, second by Mr. Gibbs, to approve the six (6) recommendations included in the draft memorandum dated December 8, 2006. Upon roll call, all members voted affirmatively.

One Meridian Boulevard: Plan is before the Planning Commission. The TAC will be interested in whether there are any additional driveways off Meridian Boulevard and Paper Mill Road.

Old Business:

Road Classifications: Mr. Moll continues to work on this project.

Wilson High School – Discussion regarding parking options. No action is expected to be taken by Wilson School District this year. However, Chairman Oswald stated that any additional expansion will have to include parking.
