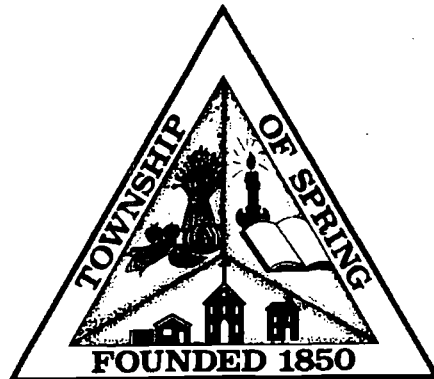

CODIFICATION

This Code of Ordinances comprises the codification of ordinances of the Township of Spring, together with the ordinances of the Borough of West Lawn, as merged into the Township of Spring effective January 1, 2006, and was prepared by Kozloff Stoudt, Professional Corporation, and re-codified and adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Spring, Berks County, Pennsylvania on August 26, 2013 by Ordinance No. 407.

ORGANIZATION

The Code of Ordinances contains the following six (6) parts:

- (1) The valid current ordinances of the Township of Spring contained in Chapters I through XXXIII.
- (2) The Spring Appendix which lists by abstracted title all ordinances of the Township of Spring of a temporary or "one time" nature.
- (3) The West Lawn Appendix which lists by abstracted title all ordinances of the Borough of West Lawn of a temporary or "one time" nature.
- (4) The Key to the Disposition of All Township of Spring Ordinances ever enacted by the Township of Spring.
- (5) The Key to the Disposition of All Borough of West Lawn Ordinances ever enacted by the Borough of West Lawn.
- (6) The Index which is an alphabetical arrangement of subjects.

In the Code, each chapter is separated by a divider tab, and specific ordinances can be located by subject on the contents page(s) at the beginning of each chapter. The Index may also be used to search for a subject when one is looking for general information on a particular subject, or if it is not known in which chapter the subject might be found.

The Appendices consists of several general categories containing a chronological listing of short subject descriptions along with a reference to the original ordinance and its date of enactment.

The Keys to the Disposition of All Ordinances indicates what action has been taken by the codifiers and the Board of Supervisors or Borough Council with regard to every ordinance ever enacted. An ordinance has been: (1) specifically repealed, (2) superseded or

repealed by another ordinance, (3) located in a chapter of the Code, or (4) located in the Appendix. The Keys are a cross reference to the original ordinance books of the Township of Spring and Borough of West Lawn and to the location within the Code of each ordinance by number.
