### Grass and Yard Waste Recycling

#### NO GRASS CLIPPINGS WILL BE COLLECTED WITH THE TRASH

The Township has established yard waste sites at designated areas for Township of Spring residents ONLY to deposit grass clippings and yard waste. The dropoff locations are along Yerger Blvd. near State Hill Road and Goose Lane near Sage Drive. GRASS OR YARD WASTE MUST BE **REMOVED FROM PLASTIC BAGS** prior to depositing at designated areas. **NO PAINTED, STAINED,** OR TREATED LUMBER. NO COMMERCIAL LANDSCAPERS

#### **Leaf Collection and Recycling**

Curbside leaf collection by Township crews will begin in October and continue through the first Friday of December. Leaves should NOT be placed in bags or containers for curbside collection or recycling. Leaves will be collected from each area of the Township on a weekly basis, Inclement weather, equipment breakdowns, or other emergencies may alter the collection schedule.

#### Christmas Tree Drop-off - Through January 31, 2022

Christmas Trees can ONLY be dropped off at the two Yard Waste sites. Goose Lane near Sage Drive & Yerger Blvd. near State Hill Road. NO CURBSIDE PICKUP. Please remove all ornaments and

# Bulk Clean Up For Limbs/Branches - Absolutely No Grass

Limbs and branches will be collected door to door on Monday, April 11, 2022 and Monday, September 26, 2022. Limbs and branches must be tied and properly bundled - maximum size 48" x 18" x 18". No roots from trees/shrubbery. Trimmings shall be tied, placed in an open container or paper lawn and leaf bag. ABSOLUTELY NO TRIMMINGS IN PLASTIC BAGS AND NO **GRASS WILL BE COLLECTED.**

#### **Trash Collection - Procedures**

Residents are provided with a BLUE 96 gallon toter by the trash hauler to be used for trash. It SHALL remain with the residence if you move. Trash shall be placed at the curb the evening before the scheduled trash collection day.

All TRASH must be placed INSIDE the Trash Toter. These toters are the only containers to be used for the automated collection. In addition to the Blue 96 gallon toter, residents are allowed ONE bulk item each collection day. Bulk items CANNOT contain CFC's, Freon, refrigerants, or gas. NO TV's, Dishwashers, Washers, Dryers, Refrigerators, Hot Water Heaters, Microwaves, Stoves, Dehumidifiers, Air Conditioners, Propane Tanks, Batteries, Automotive parts or Tires. Electronics shall not be placed in the Trash.

#### Residents shall call the Township to schedule the Bulk Item Collection at 610-678-5393.

A mattress and box spring are considered TWO bulk items. If you need an additional toter, please contact the Township office and arrange payment and delivery of another toter.

If you are unsure if an item will be collected CALL the Township first - 610-678-5393.

# **Recycling Collection - Procedures**

Residents are provided with a GREEN 96 gallon toter by the recycling hauler to be used for recycling. It SHALL remain with the residence if you move. Recycling should be placed at the curb the evening before the scheduled recycling collection day.

Place ALL recycling items in the GREEN 96 gallon toter - NOT everything is RECYCLABLE!

- Newspapers and Junk mail (DO NOT PLACE IN PLASTIC BAGS)
- FLATTENED cardboard and paperboard boxes (including cereal boxes w/out liners & flattened)
- Office paper and envelopes

- Brown paper bags (kraft)
- Glass Clear, Green or Brown
- Books (including paperbacks, telephone books, magazines and catalogs) Steel and Aluminum Cans
- · Cardboard milk and juice cartons
- Non-metalic wrapping paper
- Empty Aerosol Cans (No Paint Aerosol)

#### **Not Accepted:**

- NO PLASTIC BAGS AND NO SHREDDED PAPER, NO STYROFOAM
- NO Garbage bags, stretch film, grocery bags, packaging, etc
- . NO Batteries, Light bulbs of any kind
- NO Wax coated paper or cardboard, no hardback books
- Any material with substantial food debris (small trace amounts of food residue is ok)
- . NO Mirrors, window or auto glass, porcelain, ceramics, glass cookware/bake ware, microwave oven trays, drinking glasses, perfume/cologne bottles
- NO Coat hangers (plastic or wire)
  - NO Wire
- . NO Household items like toasters, cookware, bake ware, electronics, appliances, etc
- NO GAS CANS, HELIUM OR PROPANE TANKS
- NO Items containing or having debris and residue containing hazardous or toxic substances such as paint cans with wet paint, motor oil containers, gasoline cans, glue, petroleum products, etc
