Collection on a Saturday during the holiday week is **ALWAYS** earlier than normal, please place trash out the night before.

In those weeks with a Holiday, collection of trash and recyclables will take place ONE DAY LATER THAN USUAL beginning on the holiday through the remainder of the week. All Collection schedules will return to normal beginning Monday of the next week.

These are the only holidays observed by trash/recycling hauler  
\*NOTE: Saturday and Sunday holidays DO NOT change the pick up schedule.\*

### Grass and Yard Waste Recycling – Township Residents ONLY

Goose Lane Yard Waste Site is accessible only by key card issued to Township Residents. Go online to [www.springtwpberks.org](http://www.springtwpberks.org) to download application for key card or go to the Township Municipal Office. **\$20 application processing fee with a yearly renewal fee.** Watch for similar renovations at the Yerger Blvd Yard Waste site in 2024. **All Grass needs to be removed from PLASTIC BAGS. NO LANDSCAPERS OR COMMERCIAL BUSINESSES.**

### Leaf Collection and Recycling

Curbside leaf collection by Township crews will begin in October and continue through the **first Friday of December.** Leaves should NOT be placed in bags or containers for curbside collection or recycling. Leaves will be collected from each area of the Township on a weekly basis. Inclement weather, equipment breakdowns, or other emergencies may alter collection.

### Christmas Tree Drop-off - Through January 31, 2024

Christmas Trees can ONLY be dropped off at the two Yard Waste sites. Goose Lane near Sage Drive & Yerger Blvd. near State Hill Road. **NO CURBSIDE PICKUP.** Please remove all ornaments and stands.

### Bulk Clean Up For Limbs/Branches - Absolutely No Grass

Limbs and branches will be collected door to door on Monday, April 22, 2024 and Monday, October 7, 2024. Limbs and branches **must** be tied and properly bundled – maximum size 48" x 18" x 18". **No roots from trees/shrubbery.** Trimmings shall be tied, placed in an open container or paper lawn and leaf bag. **ABSOLUTELY NO TRIMMINGS IN PLASTIC BAGS AND NO GRASS WILL BE COLLECTED.**

### Trash Collection - Procedures

Residents are provided with a **BLUE 96 gallon toter** by the trash hauler to be used for trash. **It SHALL remain with the residence if you move.** Trash shall be placed at the curb the evening before the scheduled trash collection day.

**All TRASH must be placed INSIDE the Trash Toter.** These toters are the only containers to be used for the automated collection. In addition to the **Blue 96 gallon toter**, residents are allowed **ONE bulk item each collection day.** Bulk items **CANNOT** contain CFC's, Freon, refrigerants, or gas. **NO TV's, Dishwashers, Washers, Dryers, Refrigerators, Hot Water Heaters, Microwaves, Stoves, Dehumidifiers, Air Conditioners, Propane Tanks, Batteries, Automotive parts or Tires.** Electronics shall not be placed in the Trash.

Residents shall call the Township to schedule the Bulk Item Collection at 610-678-5393. A mattress and box spring are considered **TWO** bulk items. No construction materials shall be placed out for trash. Carpet shall be cut to 4 feet or less and rolled. If you need an additional toter, please contact the Township office as there is a fee involved.

If you are unsure if an item will be collected CALL the Township first – 610-678-5393.

### Recycling Collection - Procedures

Residents are provided with a **GREEN 96 gallon toter** by the recycling hauler to be used for recycling. **It SHALL remain with the residence if you move.** Recycling should be placed at the curb the evening before the scheduled recycling collection day.

Place **ALL** recycling items in the **GREEN 96 gallon toter** - NOT everything is RECYCLABLE!

- Newspapers and Junk mail (DO NOT PLACE IN PLASTIC BAGS)
- FLATTENED cardboard and paperboard boxes (including cereal boxes w/out liners & flattened)
- Office paper and envelopes
  - Brown paper bags (kraft)
- Books (including paperbacks, telephone books, magazines and catalogs)
- Glass – Clear, Green or Brown
  - Steel and Aluminum Cans
- Cardboard milk and juice cartons
  - Non-metallic wrapping paper
- Empty Aerosol Cans (No Paint Aerosol)

### Not Accepted:

- NO PLASTIC BAGS AND NO SHREDDED PAPER, NO STYROFOAM
- NO Garbage bags, stretch film, grocery bags, packaging, etc
- NO Batteries, Light bulbs of any kind

- NO Wax coated paper or cardboard, no hardback books
- Any material with substantial food debris (small trace amounts of food residue is ok)
- NO Mirrors, window or auto glass, porcelain, ceramics, glass cookware/bake ware, microwave oven trays, drinking glasses, perfume/cologne bottles
- NO Coat hangers (plastic or wire)
  - NO Wire
- NO Household items like toasters, cookware, bake ware, electronics, appliances, etc
- NO GAS CANS, HELIUM OR PROPANE TANKS
- NO Items containing or having debris and residue containing hazardous or toxic substances such as paint cans with wet paint, motor oil containers, gasoline cans, glue, petroleum products, etc
